**Safe Work Procedure:**

- 1) Use a proper blade, which is marked for dry cutting.
- 2) Remove the water curtain.
- 3) Disconnect the water pump.
- 4) Use step cutting when using abrasive blades.
- 5) Use jam or step cutting when using dry cutting diamond blades.

***If an emergency situation occurs while conducting this task, or there is an equipment malfunction, engage the emergency stop and follow the lock out procedure***
