Safe Work Procedure:

- 1) Do pre-trip inspection on machine and start
- 2) Check back up alarm, lights, all gauges, and hydraulics
- 3) Check all belts for wear and proper alignment and tension
- 4) Check electrolyte level in battery
- 5) Check tires for unusual wear and proper inflation
- 6) Wear a seat belt
- 7) When proceeding to the work location, check the brakes

If an emergency situation occurs while conducting this task, or there is an equipment malfunction, engage the emergency stop and follow the lock out procedure
