**Safe Work Procedure:**

- 1) Make sure all protective guards and covers are in place.
- 2) Only operate machine while you are in the seat with the seat belt on
- 3) Operate the attachment slowly in open area and check for proper operation of controls and protective devices
- 4) Ensure no personnel are in harm's way
- 5) Not any repairs during operation of attachment and report them to your supervisor
- 6) Carry attachments approximately 5 inches about ground level.
- 7) Maintain control of the machine when operating the attachment and don not overload the machine beyond its capacity.
- 8) Maintain a line of sight with the attachment at all times

***If an emergency situation occurs while conducting this task, or there is an equipment malfunction, engage the emergency stop and follow the lock out procedure***
