**Safe Work Procedure:**

- 1) Store material away from a heat source
- 2) Ensure adequate ventilation in storage area
- 3) Check building and fire codes for specific storage regulations
- 4) Keep containers closed when not in use
- 5) Supply adequate firefighting and spill clean up equipment
- 6) Ensure that products have warning labels
- 7) Ensure that good housekeeping standards are met
- 8) Ensure MSDS is available for emergency purposes

***If an emergency situation occurs while conducting this task, or there is an equipment malfunction, engage the emergency stop and follow the lock out procedure***
