Safe Work Procedure:

- 1) Complete pre trip inspection before use, including complete fluid check
- 2) Ensure horn and back up alarm are working
- 3) Ensure truck is equipped with a portable fire extinguisher
- 4) Raise and lower box to ensure it is working properly
- 5) Check braking systems carefully
- 6) Be sure parking brake/device is working
- 7) Fill out inspection report

If an emergency situation occurs while conducting this task, or there is an equipment malfunction, engage the emergency stop and follow the lock out procedure
