Safe Work Procedure:

- 1) Back up to the dumping location with the use of a spotter
- 2) Park and ensure brake is applied
- 3) Exit cab using three point contact and inspect the ground to ensure it is level and firm
- 4) Roll up tarp
- 5) Enter cab using three point contact
- 6) Engage PTO and pump
- 7) When hoist is lifting, trip the end gate
- 8) Hoist box to the final stage
- 9) When load is dumped slowly drive ahead a few feet and lower hoist
- 10) Disengage pump and PTO and close end gate.

If an emergency situation occurs while conducting this task, or there is an equipment malfunction, engage the emergency stop and follow the lock out procedure
