

TRAINING POLICIES TIMELINE

The tendering requirements and apprenticeship training policies will be phased in over the next three years.

Beginning July 1, 2011

- bidders, contractors and subcontractors will be required to complete a bidder's certification form for legislative and safety requirements;
- bidders must be COR/SECOR certified or enrolled in the program, where the project value is \$150,000 or greater;
- bidders with more than 20 employees and all mechanical contractors, bidders and subcontractors must be engaged in apprenticeship training; and
- bidders, contractors and subcontractors on selected government pilot projects will be required to complete the bidder's certification form for opportunities for Aboriginal people.

Beginning January 1, 2012

- bidders and subcontractors must be COR/SECOR certified or enrolled in the program, where the project value is \$150,000 or greater.

Beginning April 1, 2012

- bidders with more than 10 employees and sub-contractors with more than 20 employees must be engaged in apprenticeship training.

Beginning January 1, 2013

- bidders and subcontractors must be COR/SECOR certified or enrolled in the program, where the project value is \$100,000 or greater.

Beginning April 1, 2013

- bidders and sub-contractors with more than 10 employees must be engaged in apprenticeship training.

Beginning January 1, 2014

- all bidders and subcontractors must be COR/SECOR certified.

Beginning April 1, 2014

- all bidders and subcontractors must be engaged in apprenticeship training.
