Safe Work Procedure:

- 1) Inspect ATV before each use
- 2) Wear appropriate protective equipment while riding
- 3) Be alert to changing terrain
- 4) Be cautious of excessively rough, slippery or loose terrain
- 5) Ride ATV alone, passengers are not allowed
- 6) Check tire pressure
- 7) Ensure that headlights and taillights are working properly
- 8) Check fluid levels

If an emergency situation occurs while conducting this task, or there is an equipment malfunction, engage the emergency stop and follow the lock out procedure
