**Safe Work Procedure:**

- 3) Stay alert and periodically look at surroundings to ensure safety
- 4) Request assistance to move all heavy or awkward objects
- 5) Practice good housekeeping

***If an emergency situation occurs while conducting this task, or there is an equipment malfunction, engage the emergency stop and follow the lock out procedure***
