Safe Work Procedure:

- 1) Complete pre-trip inspection. Conduct a general walk around and look for leans, worn belts, track conditions, etc.
- 2) Mount using 3 point contact
- 3) Load the truck at the pit or snow collection area
- 4) Haul material to the dump site. Obey traffic rules.
- 5) Ensure reverse alarm is working
- 6) Use a dump man to aid in guiding the truck to the dump location
- 7) Check unload site for obstacles/hazards
- 8) Dump load
- 9) Shut down using hot engine stopping procedure
- 10) Service the machine for any wear or loose belts
- 11) Grease all points for the machine daily except for the track tensioner.
- 12) Dismount using 3 point contact

If an emergency situation occurs while conducting this task, or there is an equipment malfunction, engage the emergency stop and follow the lock out procedure
