Safe Work Procedure:

- 1) Use all applicable PPE.
- 2) Use a buddy system and do not work alone.
- 3) Shut off and lock out crusher and motor.
- 4) Notify other employee(s) of your intent.
- 5) Have adequate instruction and training in the maintenance of equipment.
- 6) Ensure all shields are secured back in place when adjustment / maintenance is complete

If an emergency situation occurs while conducting this task, or there is an equipment malfunction, engage the emergency stop and follow the lock out procedure
