GENERAL	Protecting workers from injuries associated with crushing operations
APPLICATION	Crushing operations involve heavy equipment, loaders conveyers and other vehicles
PROTECTIVE MECHANISMS	Safe job procedures Manufacturers specifications P.P.E. Lockout procedures
SELECTION AND USE	As per job requirement
SUPERVISOR RESPONSIBILITY	Supervisors are responsible to facilitate and/or provide proper instruction to their workers on protection requirements and training
WORKER RESPONSIBILITY	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A worker must be conversant with worksite operations that are part of a crushing operation. 2. Operators must be familiar with the lock out system. 3. Under NO circumstances proceed to attempt to rectify any electrical and/or hydraulic problems without first “locking out” the equipment. 4. Do not cross, jump or touch any moving conveyer. 5. Always use ladders and the provided ingress and egress points from all crushing equipment. 6. Loader operators must maintain good housekeeping.
