Every purchase has an economic, social, environmental, and cultural impact. The City of Winnipeg, like other municipalities across Canada, is adopting Sustainable Procurement practices to intentionally recognize the work already being done by Suppliers to create positive impact and to amplify the positive impacts that can happen through spending.

City Council voted in 2022 to adopt the Sustainable Procurement Action Plan, a phased-in and iterative approach plan that will work to enhance fair, open and transparent purchasing across all four pillars of Sustainable Procurement: environmental, ethical, social, and Indigenous.

The City is working with Buy Social Canada on the implementation of this plan and tools. You are invited to attend a virtual training session on **September 20, 2023, 11am-12:30pm** or **September 27, 2023, 11am-12:30pm** to learn about sustainable procurement and two new tools that will be found in the City's competitive bid solicitations – the Social Procurement Questionnaire and Environmental Procurement Questionnaire.
